


Letter from the President ~ John Toles

Enid Writers Club Minutes, Sept 7, 2023

- The meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm by President John Toles. Fourteen members were present: Cathy Thorp, Karen Evans, Bobbie Mardis, Dennis McDonald, Erica Roark, Martha Draper, Peggy Chambers, Cathy Thomas, John Toles, Theri Ray, Cam Prochaska, Paula Benge, Gwen Valdez, and Emalyn Terry. Attended by Zoom: Hannah Ward.
- There were no corrections to the minutes, as reported in the newsletter. Secretary's minutes were approved.
- There was one question concerning the Treasurer's Report of \$841.65, as reported in the newsletter. The report will be filed for audit. *Question: Does the club have any outstanding debt?*Answer: There are no debts outstanding.
- Three expenses were incurred over the summer. The annual cost for Zoom was \$149.90, allowing remote attendance of our meetings. Printing cost for our yearbook was \$34, and updating our website increased the yearly subscription to \$48.
- John Toles went over the yearbook, explaining the monthly roll call and the annual writing contest.
- Peggy Chambers gave an overview of OWFI, its activities and spring conference.
- Theri Ray promoted a free event at the Enid Public Library, a visit from author Quraysh Ali Lansana.
- The upcoming workshop to be held October 28 was discussed. We are asking for a \$500 grant.
- A motion was made by Bobbie Mardis to advance the use of \$500 of club money for the workshop until grant money is received. It was seconded by Erica Roark. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Cathy Thomas to charge attendees \$15 for the workshop, including lunch. It was seconded by Peggy Chambers. Motion passed.
- It was agreed the \$1000 Writing Scholarship will take place again if funding can be obtained.
- Critique will be held at Bobbie's house on each 3rd Thursday of the month at 6:30 pm.
- Emalyn (Emma) Terry read for membership.
- The meeting ended at 7:35 pm.
